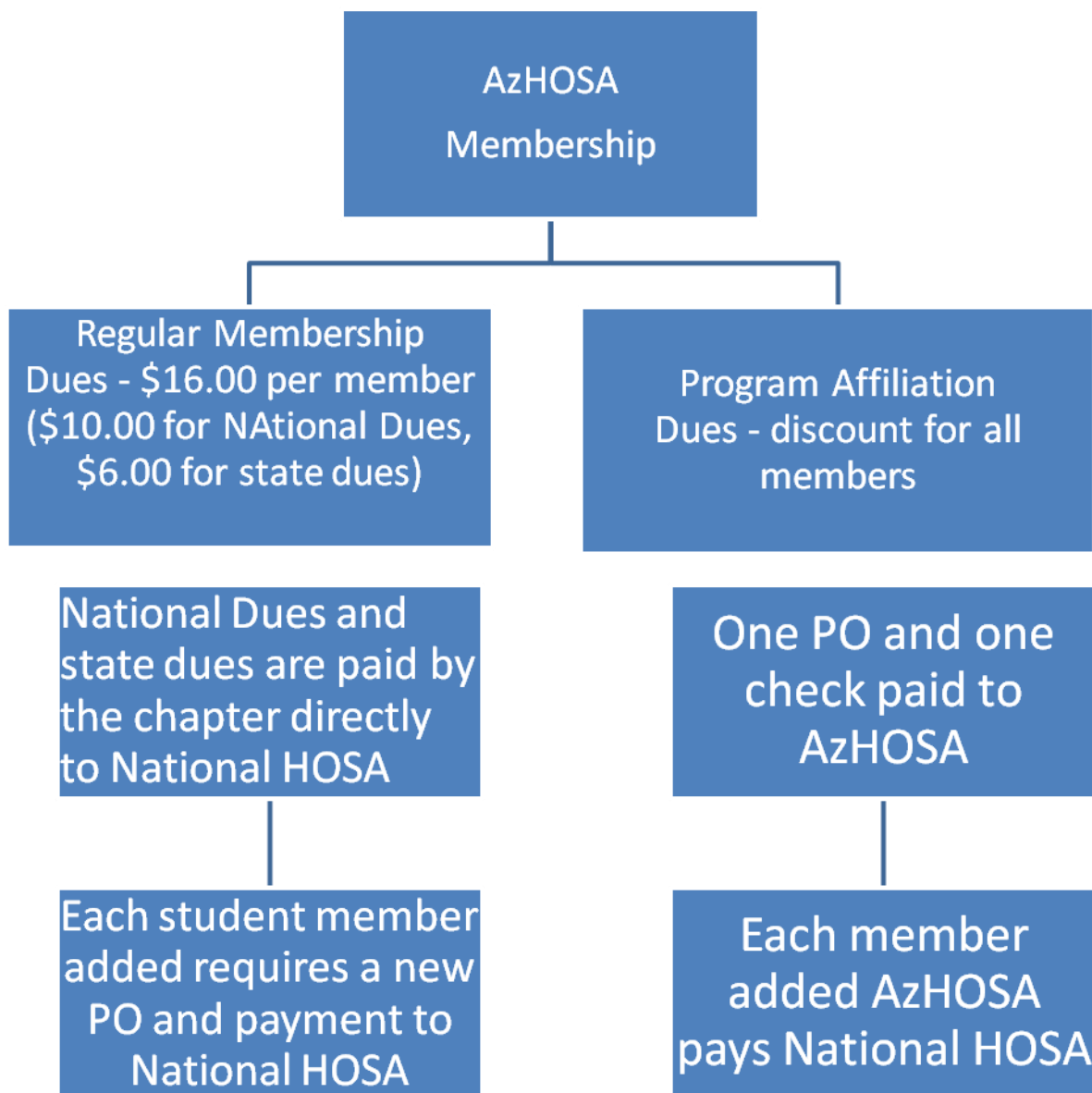




## Arizona HOSA Membership Options



## 2009-10 Arizona HOSA State Membership Affiliation Program

Arizona HOSA prepares students for a career in healthcare by providing opportunities to develop the knowledge, skills, professionalism needed to be successful in that career.

The Arizona HOSA State Membership Affiliation Program allows all eligible career and technical students and teachers to effectively integrate HOSA into Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage programs.

### Philosophy of why to affiliate with Arizona HOSA:

- Involvement in HOSA is an integral part of a Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage programs and therefore should not be optional
- Participating in Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) activities helps students develop additional employability skills that cannot be duplicated at the classroom level.
- Students understand the role and importance of “professional associations” in the healthcare workforce.
- Students receiving education through a complete **Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage program** will not only enjoy a well-rounded educational experience that leads to higher career satisfaction rates but will also experience significantly decreased drop-out rates and overall higher grade point averages.
- Teachers have many networking and professional development opportunities at local, state and national levels.
- Students and teachers benefit from curricula, leadership and skill development experiences that enhance the State of Arizona’s, Career and Technical Education Division’s program standards.

## What is the State Membership Affiliation Plan?

The State Membership Affiliation Plan allows students who are enrolled in a Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage Program to be eligible for the benefits and opportunities of HOSA as a part of the total program delivery. This plan also focuses on the development of essential employability, participative and attitude development skills as called for in the U.S. Department of Labor's Secretary's Commission on Achieving Necessary Skills (SCANS) Report.

Under the State Membership Program Affiliation Plan, all students are HOSA members. All students in a Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage Program are simply signed up using a scaled membership affiliation fee.

## How Does the State Membership Affiliation Program Work?

For a flat fee, all students in a single Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage Program joins HOSA under an agreement and fee based on student enrollment. **Invoices will be e-mailed to you from Arizona HOSA, and all payments need to be mailed to the state office.**

## What are the Benefits of State Membership Affiliation?

- **Eliminate dues collection.**

One fee covers all students in a Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage Program. Please note that affiliation on the chapter level is designed to eliminate individual dues. As a part of this program, local dues may not be collected. Other fees may be collected by the school under curriculum or activity fees in accordance with local or state policy.

- ***Each State Affiliated HOSA chapter will receive the following curriculum and services:***

- *Chapter visit from the State Advisor or a State officer*
- *Discount on Conference Registration Fees*

- **Participate in quality training**

Arizona HOSA offers premier training for chapter leaders which can be brought back to and utilized in each local program.

## How is pricing calculated for a State Membership Affiliation Program?

State Membership Program Affiliation pricing categories are based on the Nursing Services, Allied Health Services, Bioscience, Dental Assisting, Diagnostic and Intervention Technologies, Mental and Social Health Services and Therapeutic Massage Program enrollment submitted by schools during the 2008-09 school year. Your initial affiliation category is determined by your 2008-09 program enrollment numbers your school submitted to the Arizona Department of Education/CTE Division.

If, during the course of the year, your program enrollment number exceeds your current category limit, the school will be invoiced for the difference. The additional charge will be the difference between the current affiliation category fee and the new higher affiliation category fee.

## **What is required to sign up for the State Membership**

### **Affiliation Plan?**

- **Fill out and submit the affiliation contract.** Upon receipt of the affiliation contract, an invoice will be issued for the appropriate amount
- **Logon to [www.hosa.org](http://www.hosa.org) website and enter all student names and information.** You will need to know your chapter ID number and password in order to affiliate. If you are a new chapter you will need to contact the HOSA State Advisor for a chapter ID and password.
- **Submit all necessary forms and maintain current financial standing.** All Advisors must fill out and turn in the following forms
  - Chapter Registration Form
  - Advisor's Statement of Assurance Form
  - Advisor Code of Conduct
  - Chapter Bylaws
  - Program of Work

All students who attend any HOSA events must also complete a HOSA Code of Conduct and a Medical Liability form. In addition prompt payment for this and other fees incurred throughout the year is also requisite of any chapter choosing to affiliate.
