Bylaws

Article I-Name

The name of the organization shall be AzHOSA, Mingus Union Chapter

Article II-Purpose

The purpose of the organizations are:

1. To create more interest and understanding in the intelligent choice of a healthcare career.
2. To unite in a common bond without regard to race, creed or national origin student enrolled in Mingus HOSA
3. To develop leadership that is competent and self-reliant
4. To motivate students to accept academic challenges through competitive events
5. To improve scholarship and develop skills that will enable young men and women to participate effectively in a healthcare career.
6. To engage in individual and group projects
7. To recognize outstanding leadership
8. To school loyalty and help preserve the principles of democracy
9. To instill leadership in students

Article III-Organization

Section 1. AzHOSA is chartered by the Board of Directors of the National HOSA to provide for state-wide coordination of the HOSA program.

Section 2. This organization is open to all students in a health science program and those interested in, planning to pursue or are pursuing a career in the health care programs at Mingus.

Section 3. Membership is unified on the state and national level. Membership is established by payments of local, state and national dues.

Members pay \$5 personal and VACT pays \$11 to equal total of \$16 dues.

Article IV-Membership

Any students enrolled in the CAN program is entitles to become an active member of the CAN sect of HOSA. Not including Sports Med sect.

Article V-Officers

Section 1. Officers of the Mingus Union Chapter shall consist of the following:

Section 2. The teachers associated with CAN shall serve as advisor(s) to the chapter

Section 3. Officers of the chapter shall be nominated and elected by a majority vote at the beginning of the school year.

Section 4. Vacancies on the officer team shall be filled by the advisor and/or officer team

Article VI-Meetings

Section 1. One business meeting shall be held monthly during the school year.

Section 2. Additional meetings shall be called when necessary.

Section 3. The officer team shall meet prior to each monthly meeting at the time specified by the President or Advisor.

Article VII-Committees

Section 1. Committees of Mingus shall consist of the following: Community service, HOSA activites, Public Relations, Social Activities, Fundraising, Community Service and Professional Development. These all should reflect needs of the chapter.

Section 2. The chairman of the committees shall be appointed by the officer team and approved by the membership.

Article VIII-Amendments

These bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any regular chapter meeting, provided the amendment has been proposed by the officer team or any chapter member. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing at least 60 days before the next regular meeting. All proposed amendments must be submitted by the AzHOSA to the chartered Chapters at least 30 days prior to the regular meeting.

Article IX-Parliamentary Authority

The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall govern the organization in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these Bylaws, the bylaws or corporate charter of HOSA, Inc. and any special rules the organization may adopt.
