

REMEMBERING THE HEROES OF 9/11

We at AzHOSA Thank the heroes of 9/11. Though a tragic day, people preserved through and put away differences to save each other's lives.

Below are just some of the unsung heroes to be thanked and remembered. Gone but never forgotten.



RICK RESCORLA LED MORE THAN 2,700 OF HIS EMPLOYEES OUT OF THE BUILDING.

RICK PREVIOUSLY PRACTICED SAFETY DRILLS REGULARLY AND TO CALM OTHERS DOWN, HE SANG SONGS. HE WAS LAST SEEN ON THE 10TH FLOOR OF THE SOUTH TOWER HEADING UPSTAIRS, LOOKING FOR MORE PEOPLE TO SAVE

WHEN FLEEING THE WORLD TRADE CENTER, MANY CIVILIANS ENDED UP NEAR THE HUDSON RIVER. MORE THAN 150 FERRIES, YACHTS, TOUR BOATS, AND TUGBOATS RUSHED TO THE AREA TO RESCUE PEOPLE. THE BOATS PICKED UP ALMOST 500,000 PEOPLE, TAKING THEM TO STATEN ISLAND, ELLIS ISLAND, AND NEW JERSEY. IT WAS THE LARGEST WATER RESCUE OPERATION IN AMERICAN HISTORY.



WELLES CROWTHER WAS AN EQUITES TRADER WHO HELPED STRANGERS ESCAPE THE 78TH FLOOR OF THE SKY LOBBY. HE WENT AS FAR AS TO CARRY A WOMAN ON HIS BACK 15 FLIGHTS! HE LATER WENT BACK UP AGAIN. HE DIED AT AGE 24 BUT BECAME KNOWN AS "THE MAN IN THE RED BANDANA "

Signs of Suicidal Thoughts

Suicide is a serious and growing problem, but there are a few signs that might indicate that someone may be suicidal. If you see these signs in a friend or a loved one, reach out to them, or a trusted adult.

- Talking about death, dieing or wanting to die
- Self-harm
- Giving away possessions
- Talking about things never getting better
- Feeling hopeless, alone, lonely, ot anxious and worried

A teen or young adult dies by suicide every hour and a half

In 2021 there was an estimated 1.7 million suicide attempts



There are 132 deaths by suicide everyday

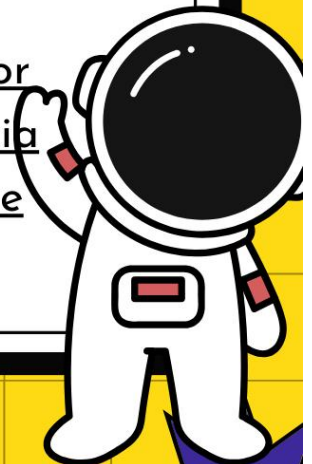
