## **Competitors MUST bring to STATE AND INTERNATIONAL Leadership Conference:**

- 1. Photo ID
- 2. Two #2 pencils (not mechanical)

- 1. Clock with hour : minute : seconds (for time monitoring)
- 2. Test booklet
- 3. Answer document

## State Leadership Conference Event Flow (see official guidelines for test plan and more information):

- 1. Competitors will arrive at the State Leadership Conference and Check In at the event room with the Event Manager at the START of the posted event time frame.
- 2. Competitor will provide a photo ID to the Event Manager during check-in

- 3. Event staff will issue a test booklet to the competitor
- 4. Event staff will seat the competitor and write the official START time on the top of the answer sheet and test booklet
- 5. Competitors will have 60 minutes to complete the test they are responsible for monitoring the time using the provided clock.
- 6. Competitor will return the test booklet and answer document to the Event Staff when finished.
- 7. Competitors should complete the event survey and leave the competition area.

NOTE: Competitors may begin the test the moment they are seated. There will be competitors starting and ending at various times in the room. The room will NOT be guaranteed to be a quiet testing environment.

## **Final Scoring and Advancing:**

To be eligible to advance, competitors must achieve a final score of at least 70%, calculated by combining points from all event components (such as digital uploads) and subtracting any penalties for violations (such as failing to provide a Photo ID).

For advancing from <u>SLC to ILC</u> only the top 5 scores meeting this minimum requirement will be called to the stage and the top 3 will advance to ILC with 4th and 5th place being eligible for substitution.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

- 1. Can I bring more than one pencil to the event? Yes, you may bring as many as you think you will need. It is NOT recommended to bring mechanical pencils as they tend to not be very dark.
- 2. I arrived a few minutes late. Can I still start? Yes, the format of the testing room is considered to be a "rolling start". Check in for the event will start promptly at the posted time and competitors will start the test once they are seated.
- 3. I do not need the full 60 minutes do I have to sit there and wait for the time to end? No, once you are finished with the exam you may return it to the event staff and leave the testing area.
