#### Study, Study, Study!!

Members interested in competing in one of these events should review the event guidelines to get an idea of the content and process for these events. The guidelines will give them a test breakdown, list of resources, and even sample questions. If Round 2 involves skill demonstration, the guidelines will list the skills and provide rubrics to help them prepare.

#### Online Testing

Members interested in competing in these events will take the online test sometime during the testing window. Chapters are responsible for scheduling the tests when it works best for them. There is no limit to online testing. Students can take multiple tests and chapters are not limited in how many members can take any online test. SLC qualifiers are based on rank, not score, and will be released to advisors after the close of the testing window.

#### State Leadership Conference

Members qualifying from the online testing should be registered to attend the State Leadership Conference in the spring. Event guidelines will indicate what members will be doing at the SLC, which might be demonstrating skills, presentation, or another test. The top 3 in each event at SLC qualify to attend the International Leadership Conference in June. 4th and 5th place finishers may also “bump” if one of the top three declines their spot.

*\*Note - Each chapter gets a certain number of entries per event based on the size of their chapter: 5-50 members = 2 entries per event, 51-100 members = 3 entries per event, 101+ members = 4 entries per event*
