Regional Registration and Upload

Members competing in these events go directly to Regional Conferences. Advisor should register them ahead of the published RLC deadline, and competitors in the starred events should upload their materials by the same deadline.

**Note - Each chapter gets a certain number of entries per event based on the size of their chapter: 5-50 members = 2 entries per event, 51-100 members = 3 entries per event, 101+ members = 4 entries per event*

Regional Conference

Members competing in these events will need to attend the applicable Regional Conference to present to the judges. They should use the guidelines and provided rubrics to help them best prepare their presentations. They will be judged at the Regional Conference and the top performers in each region will qualify to advance to the State Leadership Conference.

State Leadership Conference

Members advancing from Regional Conferences should be registered to attend the State Leadership Conference in the spring. If their event required an upload for RLC, they will need to re-upload for SLC and will present again to judges at the SLC. The top 3 in each event at SLC qualify to attend the International Leadership Conference in June. 4th and 5th place finishers may also “bump” if one of the top three declines their spot.

International Leadership Conference

ILC qualifiers should be registered by their advisors and resubmit any required digital uploads ahead of the May 15th deadline. Students will attend the ILC and present again to judges in hopes of being named an International Event Finalist or winner!! Good Luck!!
